19th June is celebrated as READING /DIGITAL READING DAY and from 19th June to 18th July as READING/DIGITAL READING MONTH throughout the country for the past 24 years to inculcate reading habit among children and underprivileged as well as digital technologies as part of building knowledge societies. The day is also important that it is the annual remembrance day of P.N. Panicker, father of library and literacy movement, who converted a simple slogan 'READ AND GROW' into a powerful movement to achieve universalisation of education.

Earlier the celebrations main focus were to inculcate reading habit and thereby fostering book mindedness among the children and under privileged.

From the overwhelming response of the children, young adults and public, the one day celebration was transformed into week-long celebrations and latter month long activities. In 2003 P.N. Panicker Foundation initiated the familiarization of electronic reading through internet enabled reading in the metro cities of the state for the first time in the country.

During the 22nd READING DAY celebrations organized at Kochi on 17th June 2017 at a colourful function, Prime Minister Shri. Narendra Modiji came down to Kerala and inaugurated this much popular celebrations hitherto celebrated in Kerala and few parts of other states and Gulf countries.

Prime Minister directed P.N. Panicker Foundation to celebrate this novel initiative throughout the country and make it as a national people's movement giving emphasis on Digital Reading also with month long activities in all schools, colleges, educational institutions and Panchayats of the country. He further directed the Foundation to reach the message of Reading and Digital Reading so as to reach 300 million population of the country by 2022 when the country celebrates its 75th year of independence. The Prime Minister was magnanimous enough to make it as a national level month long programme, every year from June 19th to 18th July stressing the importance on reading and digital reading for inclusive growth.

Soon after the inauguration, the Prime Minister sitting in the aircraft tweeted the importance of reading and highlighted P.N. Panicker Foundation's gesture of "presenting books instead of bouquet in all public functions" while greeting the VIPS. Latter in his much acclaimed national AIR programme-MANN KI BAAT-in its 33rd episode of 25th June 2017 exhorted the public to "Present a Book instead of Bouquet in all public functions" by emulating the practice of P.N. The Prime Minister was kind enough to instruct NITI Aayog, Govt. of India to support P.N. Panicker National Reading Mission activities in achieving universalisation of education. Subsequently NITI Aayog gave umbrella support to P.N. Panicker Foundation by advising all the Chief Sectaries of the States and Administrators of the UT to celebrate the Reading Day Reading Month Celebrations under the leadership of District Collectors.

During 2017, we could reach about 140 districts of the country with the message of reading and digital reading, with the total population of about 32 million. In 2018 we could reach 84 million populations through 420 districts. In 2019 the P.N. Panicker Foundation with the umbrella support of NITI AYOG could touch 580 districts of the country with 162 million population. In 2020 Foundation is Celebrating 25th year of this Reading Digital Reading Movement with much splendour and colour to reach among 200 million population in 610 districts. Foundation have geared up the machinery with people's participations and blessings of Prime Minister Narendra Modiji to touch 300 million populations in all the 725 districts of the country by 2022.

Panicker Foundation is in the process of establishing 2,51,725 Digital Libraries (2,51,000 Panchayaths and 725 districts) in the country by 2025 when the country celebrates its 75th year of the formation of the Indian Republic for achieving inclusive education.


- Most of the schools in the country had established reading period in a week to inculcate reading habit and foster book mindedness.

- In some of the schools the students have set up reading clubs to promote reading and digital reading
- In some of the big schools where PTAs are very active they have established digital libraries with internet connectivity


IMPACT

- ❖ The outstanding feature of the Reading Month celebrations was the outreach programme organized to promote Reading and Digital Reading by the students. They have gone out of their campus and held small corner meetings in slums and areas were underprivileged population are thickly populated.

- Overall the reading percentage among the children and underprivileged had improved manifold.


P.N. PANICKER READING DAY READING MONTH CELEBRATIONS 1996 to 2017



District Librarian Prabhiot Kaur said, "We have to understand that reading has to be promoted and made part of lifestyle. If anyone enjoys reading, he or she will never leave it."

The session helped them to become aware of a faster and reliable method of cashless payment initiated by the government.




